

What's happening at Nursery!

2nd February to 6th February 2015

Last week the children continued to be interested in role play based on the story of the Tiger who came to tea. They have been having journeys on the train and exploring all kinds of things that were in the story such as tea leaves and tea bags, jelly and sandwiches. Lots of great opportunities to learn new language and use this language in their play. At lunchtime the children have been getting involved in serving themselves to their dinner, clearing their tables and setting them up for the next sitting. They are really growing in confidence now and showing how independent they can be. This is something they can continue to do at home-get them involved in helping you get ready for mealtimes- counting out the cutlery and taking things to and from the table. Tasks like these can build your child's confidence and their competency. Outside the children have been exploring droppers, syringes and basters to mix and move water and food colouring. Using these simple tools helps to develop muscles in the fingers and hands and strengthen them ready for writing. In Cherry room the children have continued their interests in mixing and they made cakes and rock candy. The light table has continued to be popular with children and they have been exploring the properties of different materials to see which let the light through and are transparent and which ones do not let light through and are opaque.
