


What's happening at Nursery!

9th February to 13th February 2015

Last week Sally Harper, who is an artist, came in to work with the children. She will be working in the Nursery School for two days each week until Easter. Sally will be introducing the children to some new materials and experiences and allowing them to learn some new skills. The children have started to explore wool and to try out the techniques for making felt. This activity is providing the children with lots of opportunities to develop their language as well as enabling them to be creative. They have had a great time exploring the fluffiness of the wool and the squishiness of the felt once its all wet. We are looking forward to seeing what they make with the felt. Outside there has been lots of physical play - the children have been challenging themselves on the swings and climbing equipment and taking safe risks. They need the opportunity to do this in a safe environment so that they are able to learn how to be safe and to be aware of others. Risk and challenge are essential to play too as children develop their confidence and self-esteem when they challenge themselves and do something which for them feels risky.
