Many of the children are still showing a great interest in the story "Going on a Bear Hunt." They are able to recall the story and are still revisiting the story by acting it out, writing and drawing about it.

We have been sharing a traditional story about bears with the children this week. The story Goldilocks and the three bears gives lots of opportunities to use the language of size as well as counting objects 1-3.

We are also introducing the story of the Little Red Hen as we are having two visits from the Playhouse theatre and all the children will get to be involved in this exciting production. Through helping Little Red Hen, the children explore a variety of numeracy related concepts, skills and activities including: sorting and matching, counting, recognising shapes and problem-solving. They also interact with a variety of characters, make decisions and consider notions of growth, sharing and friendship.

The artist Sally Harper, will be in Nursery school this week and for the next two weeks working with the children to undertake an art project based on the hens. The children will be producing some art work with Sally that will be used to enhance the Nursery environment.




