

Why not try to :-

Name the things you might see on a farm-tractors, fields, scarecrow, farm animals their names and the names of the their young, sheep, lambs, cows, calves, pigs, piglets.

Talk about the parts of the animals-tail, hooves, beaks, feathers, fur, udders, ears, manes.

Please return your completed form so that we can claim the extra funding allocated to all children whose parents are in receipt of the following benefits:-

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseekers Allowance
- Universal Credit
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190

We cannot claim for the extra funding without this information. Please help us to make a difference for your child.
