A really big thank you to all the parent volunteers who came along to support the visit to Ash End Farm last week. The visit was a great success and was not only great fun but also a really excellent opportunity for learning about animals and farms first hand. The children have carried on learning about farms and animals at Nursery school. Take a look at your child's Tapestry on line learning journal to see photographs of the visit and to find out what they have been learning about in Nursery school.

The good weather has allowed the children to spend a lot of time outside. They have been very active and have been taking part in lots of physical activities - collaborating and helping each other on the Asco equipment and the climbing frame as well as challenging their balancing on the bikes and scooters. They have also been planting some seeds and taking care of the plants in the garden and in the tubs.

Many of the children are also showing an interest in writing and mark making. They are looking really closely at the letters in their name and also beginning to write some words and letters from other friends' names and their families names. You can help your child by always writing their name with capital letter at the beginning of their name and using lower case letters for all the other letters - this is how they will learn to write in primary school.
