Fruit for the café

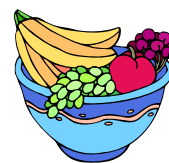
One of the contributions we ask parents to make is to bring fruit for the children to share in the café.

Stockland Green Ward Advisory Board would like to invite you, your child, your grandchild and any extended family to participate in a WORLD RECORD ATTEMPT. The World Record will take place on Remembrance Sunday, 9th November 2014, Registration starts at 1pm (after Remembrance parades).

The event will take place in BROOKVALE PARK, PARK ROAD AT JUNCTION WITH GEORGE ROAD, STOCKLAND GREEN, B23 7QB.

The World Record will see 850 people each planting 5 flower bulbs. The intention is to create a garden memorial – this will be the only Remembrance memorial within Stockland Green ward. The event is to commemorate the centenary of WW1.
