



What's happening at Nursery!

18th May to 22nd May 2015

This week we have had a focus on keeping safe in different places. Duncan and Ian, the Police Community Support Officers came into Nursery School again and this time they delivered some sessions about "Stranger Danger" to the children and also held some sessions about eSafety for parents and staff.

The children responded well to the sessions about stranger danger- Ian and Duncan talked to them about what to do if they are approached by a stranger. They were encouraged to raise the alarm by saying 'NO' to draw attention. Ian and Duncan said that they should not be scared to do this and be told that it is the right thing to do. When talking to your children be careful not to scare them too much but start with "there are bad people so it's very important you never..."

All children should ask for help from other adults. Teach them to look out for people in uniforms such as police officers, or teachers and traffic wardens if they're at the school gates. You can teach your child this basic slogan, 'DON'T GO, SAY NO'.

The sessions about esafety were very informative for staff and the parents who attended the sessions.

Some parents thought that the sessions would only apply to older children but the tips and ideas from the presentation can help all adults to keep themselves and their children safe online. As your children grow up you will be one step ahead of them!
