What's happening at Nursery School !

Monday 23rd May to Friday 27th May 2016

Last week Duncan and Ian, the Police Community Support Officers, came into Nursery School again and this time they delivered some sessions about "Stranger Danger" to some of the children. They will come back in a few weeks time to talk to the other children. The children responded well to the sessions about stranger danger- Ian and Duncan talked to them about what to do if they are approached by a stranger. The children were encouraged to raise the alarm by saying 'NO' 'to draw attention. Ian and Duncan said that they should not be scared to do this and that they should be told that it is the right thing to do. When talking to your children be careful not to scare them too much but start with "there are bad people so it's very important you never..."

All children should ask for help from other adults. Teach them to look out for people in uniforms such as police officers, or teachers and traffic wardens if they're at the school gates. You can teach your child this basic slogan, 'DON'T GO, SAY NO'.

Next half term will be very busy with lots of opportunities for you to get involved with your child's learning at Nursery school.

There will also be a family trip day during July - details to follow.

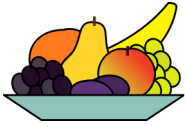
Reminder!
