8th December to 15th December 2014

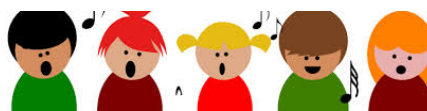
It was super to see many of you joining your children last week for the Christmas Workshops. These sessions are a great opportunity for you to learn alongside your child and to see how we encourage and support your child to learn through experiences and play. Research suggests that the more senses that are involved in an experience, the better the learning is remembered so activities such as making flapjacks, tinsel dancing and choosing decorations for the tree enable the children to use many of their senses. Giving the children choice allows them to select activities that interest them and when the adults follow their lead and join in with their play they become completely absorbed in what they are doing and their learning is deepened. The activities also support children with their language, their fine and gross motor skills, their mathematical understanding and develop their knowledge about traditions and customs around the celebration of Christmas.
