

What's happening at Nursery!

Thank you to those of you who were able to attend our listening and reading sessions last week. Getting involved in activities like this will enable you to do support your child at home with their early literacy skills and get them well prepared for their time in school if they are due to go on to a Reception Class in September. Last week's cold weather gave the children lots of opportunities to continue their interest in all things Frozen! - The ice and frost led to lots of scientific language and exploration both indoors and outdoors. You could continue this interest at home by talking about frost and ice and using words such as melting, freezing and thawing to extend your child's language. The children have also been dressing up and dancing and singing all inspired by the Frozen film and music.

The children are still continuing to be inspired by their visit to the Town hall to see "The Tiger who came to tea" and have been role playing train journeys and tea parties. In Cherry room the play dough station has been really popular. The self service flour and salt has enabled children to undertake lots of scientific exploration - mixing the ingredients and adding other things to their dough. This has again given opportunities for extending the children's vocabulary through hands on experiences. These experiences are always much more meaningful for children and they are more likely to remember the words they have learnt and use them later and in other situations.
