The children have been enjoying using all areas of the Nursery school but they have been particularly enjoying the outdoor areas. It is so important for young children to be physically active during the day.

The latest recommendation is that children under five years old should be active for at least 3 hours every day!

Think about your children- how active are they when they are with you ?

We have noticed many children still being pushed along in buggies or being carried into and out of Nursery school. Far too many children spend long amounts of time in car seats, buggies and sitting down.

Active children are healthy, happy, school ready and sleep better - so try setting out for Nursery school a little bit earlier so that they can walk and let them walk into and out of nursery.

They will benefit from the exercise and help you all to look after your backs!
