Many of the new children are now well settled and able to stay at Nursery school by themselves. Remember all children are different and some of the children will take a while to build up a trusting relationship with the staff in Nursery school. Please check with your child's key person about the time you need to come back to collect your child before you leave the building.

The staff are busy assessing the children and finding out what they are interested in and what they are good at doing as well as what they need help with.

If you have any information regarding your child's interests and their strengths and areas that they need help with then please let us know. If we work together then we can help get your child's education off to a good start. The children have all been learning about the routines in Nursery school. Staff have been supporting them to practice putting on and taking off their coats , shoes and socks. You can help your child by practicing these really important skills at home. Being independent is great for helping the children to grow in confidence and increase their self esteem. This will really help them to be good learners!
