Reception Class Places for September 2017

Children in Birmingham can go to school (Reception) in the September after their 4th birthday. That means that if your child was born between 1 September 2012 and 31 August 2013, they'll be able to start school in September 2017. You should receive information through the post.

Don't forget to apply for your child's Reception class place if they are due to leave us in July 2017.

The deadline for applying online is 4th December 2016

Click on Schools and Learning and then Apply for school place and then Apply for Reception or Primary school.
