Some of you may have seen the Highway rat on the television over the holidays which was written by Julia Donaldson too. Her stories are excellent for young children as they have lots of rhymes and repetition. The children have all come back into Nursery School very eager to get learning straight away. Playing outside is still very popular despite the inclement weather- please ensure your child has a coat with them every day and a hat too!! Please remember to put their names in their coats and hats. No scarves please as these could be dangerous when the children are playing outside.

Many of you will have heard about the new Smart Snacking guidance for young children. Change4life have a Food Scanner app for your phone that brings food labels to life and shows you just what's inside popular snacks. The advice is that your children should have "2 snacks MAX". That means only 2 packaged snacks each day.

If you look at the change4life website there are lots of ideas for 100 calorie snacks.

We have a new member of staff this term - Miss Hina Ashraf - who is working with us as a play worker supporting children's learning throughout the Nursery school.
