What's happening at Nursery School!

The children are continuing to have lots of excellent learning experiences both inside and outside the Nursery school.

The next groups of children have started to have their Forest School sessions led by Mrs Fortey. During the time your child is at Nursery school they will take part in the Forest School Sessions when staff feel they are ready. Children learn through play, have the opportunity to learn about the natural environment, how to handle risks and most importantly to use their own initiative to solve problems and co-operate with others. You will have been notified by your child's keyworker if they are taking part in sessions this half term.

Many of the children are now able to talk to their keyworker about the library books they have taken home and shared with you. You can really help to develop your child's early reading skills if they are ready by reading signs to them when you are out and about. Letting them read and share their books with you. Letting them choose their own books when you go to the library. Setting up a pretend shop where they can read the labels on the packets and boxes. Reading a recipe to them as you are making dough or cooking together.
