

What's happening at Nursery School ?



Monday 29th January to Friday 2nd February 2018

Last week the children had lots of exciting learning opportunities inside and outside the Nursery School. Many children are showing an interest in mark making, which is the first stage towards writing. Our youngest children are experimenting with different mark making in Cherry Room, in Oak room in the graphics area and outside. The children are using paintbrushes to make circles and lines on paper on the easels or on the table . When they are playing with the play dough they are developing their fine motor skills by using the rolling pins, pestle and mortars to crush herbs and cutters and tools to make marks in the dough. At home you can help their learning by drawing and painting with them and telling them what you are doing. When you are writing lists or filling in forms let them have their own paper or forms so that they can make their own marks. Many of the children who are developmentally older are now talking about their mark making and telling adults what their mark making means. They now understand that writing is different to drawing and many of them are writing recognisable letters. Some of the children can write their own name or some of the letters from their name, and a few children are attempting to write labels for their drawings or other things in the Nursery School. You can help your child's learning by telling them what you're writing as you write a shopping list. Make a name card for their bedroom door or a placemat with their name on. Let them use these to help them try to write their name by themselves.
