

What's happening at Nursery School!



Monday 2nd October 2017 to Friday 6th October 2017

This half term the children have been encouraged to notice the changes that are taking place in the natural world as part of Autumn. Talking about what the children are seeing outside at Nursery school or when walking to school or playing outside is a great way to support children's understanding of the world around them. It also gives you an opportunity to extend their language and increase their vocabulary by introducing new words in a meaningful way.

See how many new words you can use with your child. They will soon start to pick some of them up as you name the things as you point them out to your child.

At Nursery school the staff are hoping to start some planting ready for next spring. We would be very grateful for donations of spring flowering bulbs to plant in tubs and the beds on the field. Gardening is another great learning opportunity that gives lots of opportunities for learning new vocabulary and about the natural world.

If you are not sure what to bring please ask your child's keyworker.












School term dates - advanced notice

Nursery school will be closed for holidays as follows:-

For the safety of your child, their friends, and the local community we request that you park safely, legally and considerately.

Please remember that school dinners cost £1.80 per day:-
