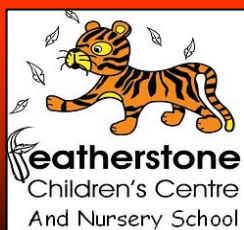


Our Ethos - It takes a whole community to raise a child



What's happening at Nursery School !

Monday 20th March to Friday 24th March 2017

The children are continuing to challenge their physical skills outside using the equipment to make more difficult apparatus. Some children were using the high jumping challenge to practise their mark making and tallying as they recorded which children had jumped highest. Mark making and using mathematical language during their play will help them to understand how useful it is to be able to write and understand mathematics.

Last week the children went on a Spring walk in the playground to look out for signs of the changing seasons. They looked for plants and trees that were beginning to grow and noticed the buds beginning to show on the trees and the daffodils and crocuses blooming. This activity helped to introduce lots of new vocabulary about plants and growing to the children. When you are out and about with your child see if you can spot some plants flowering or the buds forming on the trees and bushes. This will help them to remember any new words they have learnt. Noticing changes in the natural world around them helps them to begin to learn some scientific language. It will also help them to learn how to take care of our environment and to begin to have a sense of awe and wonder about the world around them.

The children also were able to make some simple pizza style snacks on bread using tomato sauce, cheese, and fresh tomatoes. This is a great activity for learning about changes that happen during cooking as the cheese melted and the ingredients changed colour. The pizza making also helped develop their vocabulary and their fine motor skills as well as being delicious to eat!!
