

What's happening at Nursery School?



Monday 23rd April to Friday 27th April 2018

As many of you know our eggs began hatching on Wednesday last week and we have had nine chicks successfully hatch out all of their eggs altogether. Unfortunately one egg did not hatch. The children will have another week to look closely at the chicks and watch them change over the next few days. They grow very quickly and soon begin to have some feathers.

The children also enjoyed learning outside in the glorious weather. Hopefully we will have some more sunshine. Please help us to keep your child safe in the sun! Send your child to Nursery School with a sun hat and sun cream (clearly named), and clothes that cover their shoulders. No strappy tops please as children only need 15 minutes exposure to the sun and they will burn. The recommendation is that children should have at least SPF 15 but higher factors are even better. You can apply some cream before they come in to Nursery school and we will help them to reapply some. We do have some sensitive skin sun cream in Nursery School which we can support children to apply to their arms and faces. Please let us know if your child has any allergies to sun protection products. All children must still wear shoes or trainers that protect their feet and are safe for robust physical activity. No flip flops or sandals please!
