

# What's happening at Nursery School ?



### Monday 30th April to Friday 4th May 2018

Lots of learning took place over the last two weeks about growth and change as the children were observing the eggs hatch out into chicks. Most of the chicks have now returned to the farm that supplied the eggs., but two of them have been adopted by Mrs. Allden and her family so we may be able to see how they grow over the coming months. This hands-on experience will have begun to prepare the children for the learning that will take place when we visit Ash End farm next week. Don't forget to talk to your child about the animals they will see and help them to learn the names of the adult and baby animals.

The children who stay for dinner have been enjoying using our new room. The children voted on a name for the room and have decided that it should be the "Watermelon Room".

Thankyou to all of you who have collected bottle tops and lids. We have plenty now for our project with Sally so we don't need you to collect any more for a while.

We hope many of you will and join us on either Tuesday 1st May and Thursday 3rd May for our Magical Marvellous Maths workshops. We have two students currently working in Nursery School who are both studying at the University College Birmingham (UCB). Both are undertaking a course to achieve a level 3 qualification. On Thursday last week we had our Peer to Peer Review. This is part of our school improvement process. The day was very successful and the leaders who visited were very positive about the Nursery school.
