What's happening at Nursery School !

Last week was a very busy week in Nursery School. The children have been learning about different festivals taking place this Autumn- they have learnt about the festival of Diwali and have been talking about different festivals that use lights, candles and fireworks as part of the celebrations. This will really help the children to be respectful and to have an understanding of different religions and cultures and to begin to learn that there are differences and similarities between their own families and other families. Many children have been interested in exploring light and dark and have been using torches to make shadows - some great scientific learning taking place here. There has been some interest in listening to stories about witches and making magic potions and spells. The children are really capable of understanding that these things happen in story books and the play has really helped develop their vocabulary and their imagination - great life skills as well as skills that they will need for creative writing and story writing.
